- Providing a flexible layout and configurable furniture

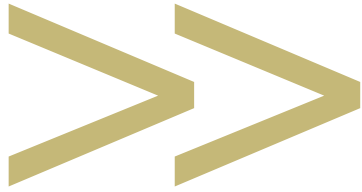

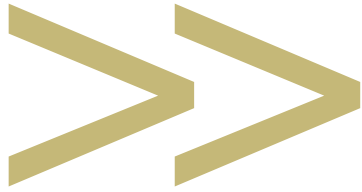
