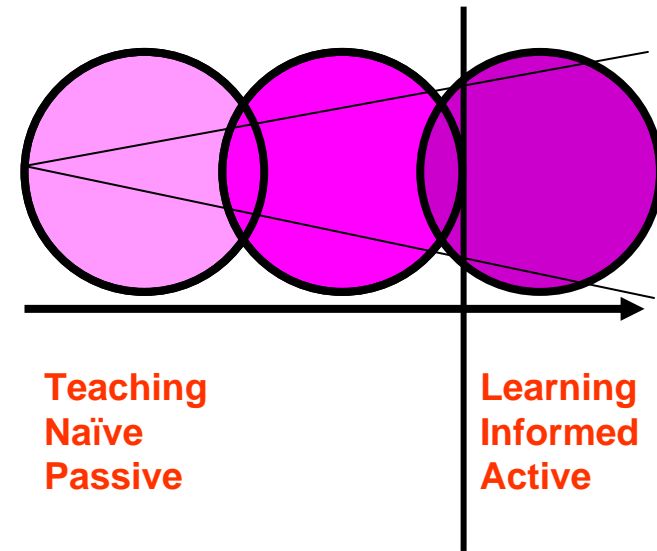
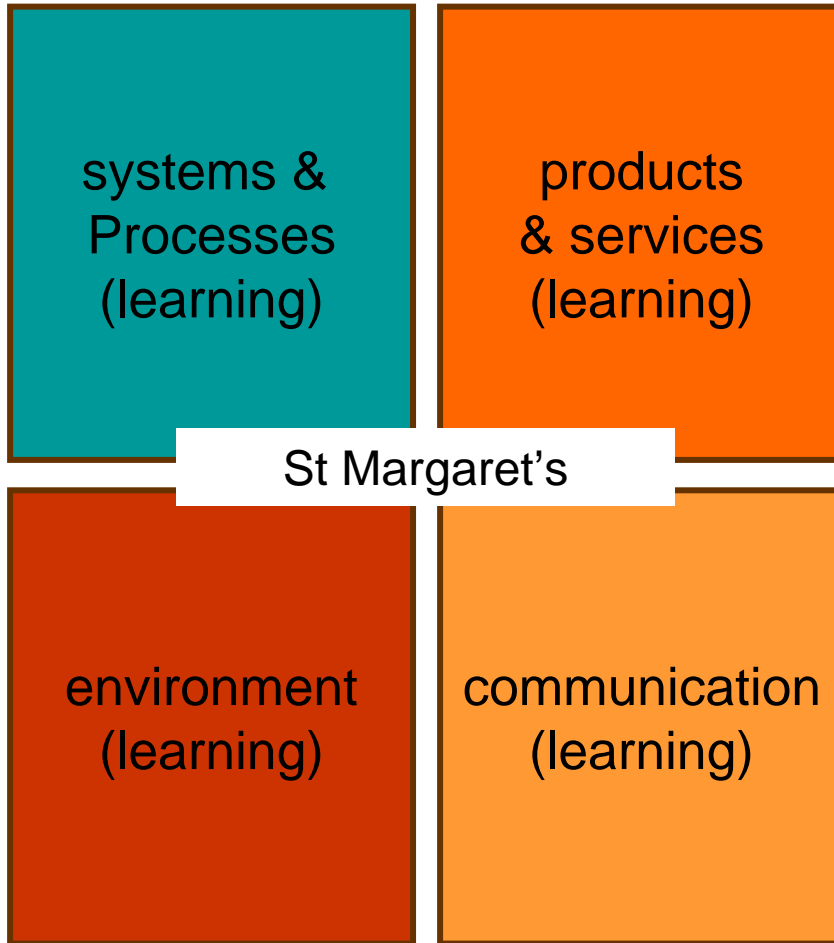


Schools Renaissance:

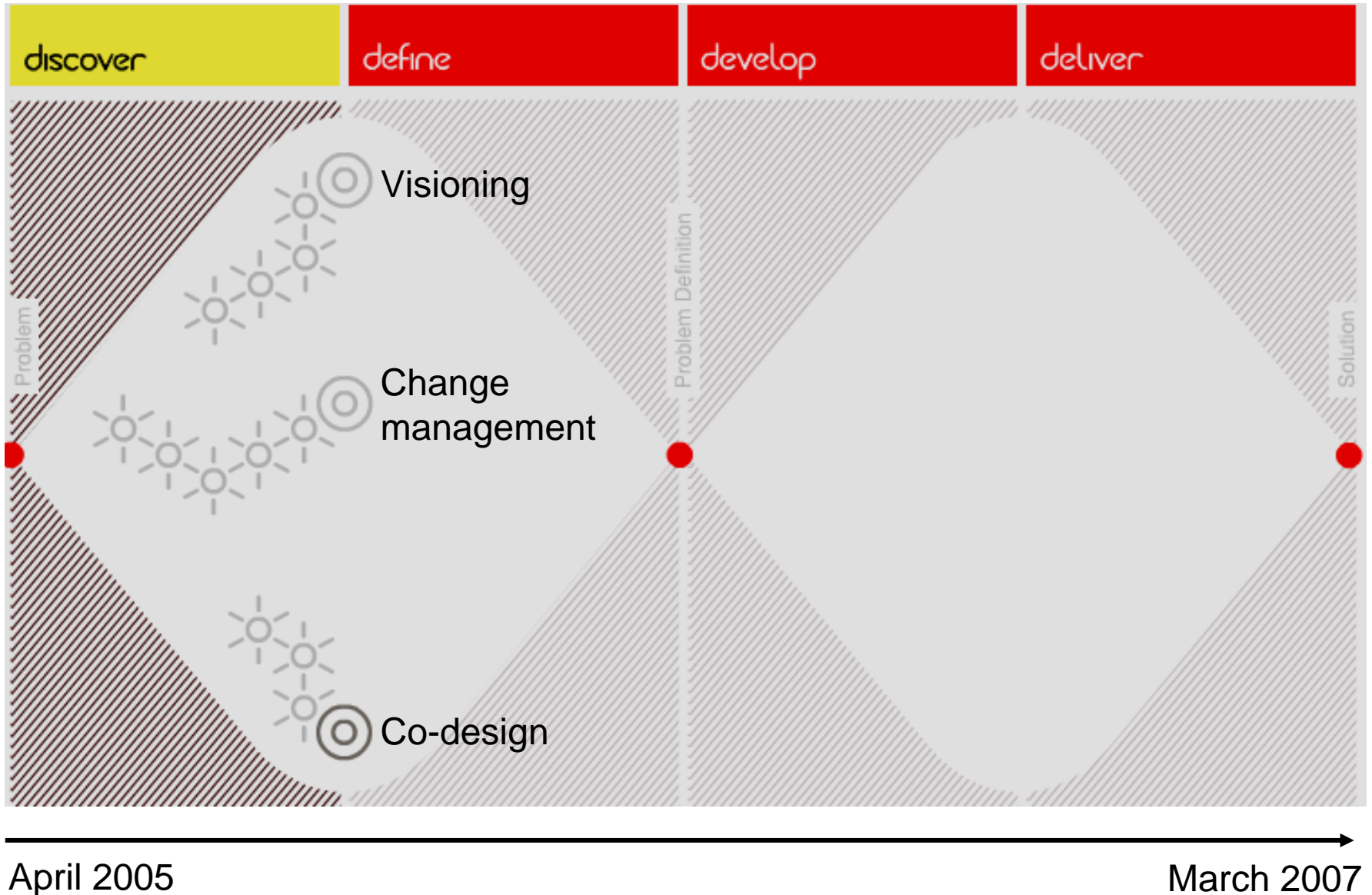
