





Sources of work for UK large practices



Work sectors for UK large practices (last 2 years)

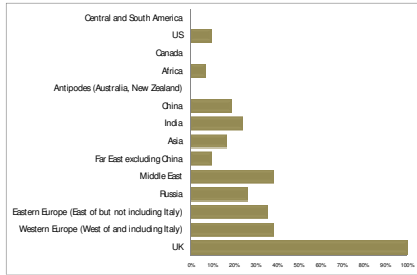

Register of practices and project opportunities to be maintained by the Hong Kong Institute of Architects on behalf of CAA

3 basic components

- a web-based register and information resource
- face-to-face meetings and seminars
- subscriber e-bulletin

Web-based data:

- The Register of practices with contact data and profiles
- List of participating national member institutes and country information
- Project opportunities
- News of partnerships and projects

- Open to practices registered with their member institutes (in the case of the UK members of the RIBA Chartered Practice scheme)
