
The Mayor's London Plan

The Mayor of London has to produce a Spatial Development Strategy - strategic planning policy for the next 20 years. He is calling it "The London Plan".

In 2001, the Mayor produced a paving document "Towards a London Plan". In June 2001, RIBA London published "Design for a Greater London" containing proposals for London's public realm, our response to "Towards a London Plan". It was launched by the then Deputy Mayor of London Nicky Gavron. The document was produced in conjunction with a range of other bodies, all committed to improving the design quality of London's built environment. See the back page of the above attachment for a list of the bodies involved.
