
The RIBA Boyd Auger Scholarship 2009

Application form

Background

In 2007, Mrs Margot Auger announced her intention to partner with the Royal Institute of British Architects (RIBA) for the creation and administration of an award to a student or group of students of Architecture, in memory of her late husband, Boyd Auger.

Mrs Auger feels that a scholarship would allow a talented student or team to travel outside the United Kingdom to work or conduct research on a topic of his/her/their choice that would contribute to the development of Architecture.

The Education Department of the Royal Institute of British Architects (RIBA) welcomes the initiative and has offered to administer the scheme through the RIBA Education Trust Funds Committee (ETFC), a sub-committee of the RIBA Education Committee.

2 Scholarship Scheme

The Scholarship, worth £5,000, will support either

- one student or a group of students for a period of research between 6 and 12 months
- or*
- one student for a period of international work experience between 6 and 12 months.

This scholarship aims to support architectural students, graduates, academics and recently-qualified architects to produce a piece of research in the field of Architecture or to support a student undergoing a period of professional experience internationally after successful completion of Part 1 and prior to enrolling in the Part 2. In this case, applicants need to be registered with a Professional Studies Advisor from their school of Architecture or the RIBA and in offer of professional placement with an architect in the country where they will be doing their professional experience. Applications for funding architecture-related work in non-governmental organisations are also welcome.

In the case of a period of research, it is expected that the scholarship would be used for a closely defined piece of architectural research. Although priority will be given to projects not leading to an academic qualification, the scholarship may be used as part of broader research at postgraduate level, namely towards a Masters or PhD/MPhil programmes.

3 Eligibility

Applicants for research funding must:

- Have graduated from an RIBA validated Part 1, 2 or 3 course or with candidate course status in the UK;
- and/or*
- Be academics and/or researchers in a School of Architecture that offers RIBA validated Part 1, 2 or 3 courses or with candidate course status in the UK.

Applicants for professional experience funding must:

- have completed their Part 1
- and*
- have been made an offer of professional placement with an architect in the country where they will work,
- and*
- be registered with a Professional Studies Advisor.

It is anticipated that the applicant will remain in employment between 6 and 12 months.

Employees or family members of the RIBA, the Auger family, trustees or members of the ETFC will not be eligible to apply for the scholarship.

Preference will be given to applicants who are RIBA Student, Associate or Chartered members.

4 Duration

Scholarships will be available from end of August 2009 subject to the recipient meeting the terms of the scholarship.

Scholarships are to be paid to recipients in two instalments:

1. First instalment, worth 80% of the total scholarship, to be awarded upon confirmation of applicants' eligibility;
2. Second instalment, worth 20%, to be awarded upon production of final piece of research.

The winner(s) of the 2009 RIBA Boyd Auger Scholarship is/are to produce two bound copies of the final report. One copy will be kept by the Auger family and the other will be kept in the RIBA British Architectural Library.

5 Deadline

The deadline for receipt of applications is **Friday, 31 July 2009**.

- i. A typed personal statement and description of project – either attached on a maximum of **SIX** A4 pages or inserted into Section E – detailing the applicant’s professional and academic circumstances to date and why the applicant feels they are eligible for a scholarship.
- ii. A reference from the applicant’s personal tutor, or head of school, and/or from the most recent work placement supervisor, indicating their support for the applicant.
- iii. If the applicant is applying for funding for a period of professional experience, s/he must produce evidence of a job offer by an architect as well as proof of being registered with a Professional Studies Advisor.

Please note that you will need to inform the Architects Registration Board (ARB) if you intend to use a period of experience outside of the EEA towards your 24 months minimum experience requirement.

You will need to maintain regular contact with your PSA for the duration of the placement, and record experience on quarterly PEDR record sheets (www.pedr.co.uk) which must be signed by your employment mentor before submission to your PSA.

Where applicable, all parts of this application must be completed. In the case of a team, only the assigned lead member of the team should complete the application.
