# Building Regulations Update

- New Part G – hygiene (particularly water use) and its cross over with Part L
- New Part L – conservation of fuel and power. The speaker will summarise the main changes and brief attendees on the methods of practical compliance
- BS9999 – a short brief on the new fire code which replaced the BS5588 series, and the design freedoms it can cover.
