

Architecture Scholarship £1500

This scholarship has been established to promote architecture and design in Wales. The scholarship will be awarded to the most promising candidate to enable him/her to further his/her understanding of creative architecture.

The scholarship is open to those under 25 years, who were born in Wales or of Welsh parents, or who have lived or worked in Wales for the three years prior to 2 August 2008, or who are able to speak or write the Welsh language.

The scholarship will be held for one year only and the successful candidate will receive £1500 to further his/her career.

The selectors will have the right to withhold or divide the scholarship between one or more candidates.

Candidates will be expected to prepare a digital portfolio on a closed CD, readable on Mac and PC platforms.

Acceptable file types include PDF (Acrobat Reader), Word, PowerPoint, Quicktime, AVQ, JPEG, GIFs, HTML, Flash Movie and Director Projector. The files will be viewed on a monitor at 72dpi. As a guideline, images should be no greater than 1mb. If a website format is used, the only plugin technologies accepted are Flash, Shockwave and Quicktime. A letter explaining how it is intended to put the scholarship to use should also be submitted. Each entry is limited to a maximum of six schemes. The work submitted may be displayed in the Eisteddfod Visual Arts Exhibition during the National Eisteddfod.

The winner of the scholarship will be expected to present a visual essay to be exhibited at the following Eisteddfod.

Entries from the fields of architecture, landscaping and design are welcome – architecture being interpreted in the broadest sense of the word. Entries by those who are not qualified architects or students of architecture are also welcome.

SPECIAL CONDITIONS

1. Who is eligible to compete?

The scholarship is open to any person under 25 years, who was born in Wales or of Welsh parents or who has resided or worked in Wales for the three years prior to 2 August 2008, or who is able to speak or write the Welsh language.

2. Entry fees and forms

The entry fee is £7.50. Candidates are invited to send a digital portfolio on a closed CD, readable on Mac and PC platforms. Acceptable file types include PDF (Acrobat Reader), Word, PowerPoint, Quicktime, AVQ, JPEG, GIFs, HTML, Flash Movie and Director Projector. The files will be viewed on a monitor at 72dpi. As a guideline, images should be no greater than 1mb. If a website format is used, the only plugin technologies accepted are Flash, Shockwave and Quicktime. It should be ensured that all links function properly and that the files can be opened with ease. A letter explaining how it is intended to put the scholarship to use should also be submitted. Each entry is limited to a maximum of six schemes.

4. Insurance

Candidates are advised to insure the disks posted to the Eisteddfod Office. Every care will be taken of work for which a receipt will be given

and the Eisteddfod will insure original work from the point of collection to the point of return to the owners.

5. General

a) The scholarship is subject to the General Rules and Conditions and to these Special Conditions. The General Rules and Conditions are listed in the list of competitions booklet, available from the Eisteddfod Office.

b) All work submitted must be the bona fide work of the candidate and must not have been exhibited in any previous National Eisteddfod.

6. Copyright

The copyright of each work remains with the candidate but the Organisers reserve the right to reproduce any of the works in any handbook or website relating to the Eisteddfod and to give permission for images of the exhibition to be published. Any work may be used for the publicity purposes of the Eisteddfod.

7. Receipt

An official receipt will be given. This receipt should be kept until the work is returned.

8. Return of disks

Please enclose a suitable stamped addressed envelope for the return of the disk.

9. Decision of selectors

The decision of the selectors will be final.

10. Architecture Scholarship

The money offered as the Architecture Scholarship is to be used to further the career of the winner. The successful candidate will be expected to prove to the Eisteddfod that the money will be used in accordance to this rule.

11. Closing date
