- Provide practical case studies and tools (such as the Net Waste Tool and Site Waste Management Plans) for evaluating project options.

Opportunities are typically in: re-use of materials and components; use of offsite and modern methods; design for materials optimisation; procurement and delivery systems; and, design for deconstruction.

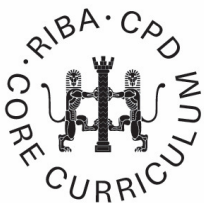
The workshop will include interactive sessions and attendees will have the opportunity to ask questions and will receive information on the range of tools and guidance available from WRAP.
