## **BUILDING REGULATIONS: DISPELLING MYTHS, DISTILLING INTERPRETATIONS**

**An update on the Building Regulations; including a closer look at interpretation and working with approved inspectors along with the functional requirements of designing steel buildings in respect of fire and air-tightness.**

Overview: This event will provide an overview of how the Building Regulations have changed in the recent past, what is up and coming and guidance on practical issues of dealing with applications.

There will be a review of the differences in working with Local Authorities and Approved Inspectors and a look at how differences of interpretation come about with suggestions on how to deal with them.

The options outside the Approved Documents will also be discussed, providing an opinion on some common errors, mistakes, myths and opinions.

In addition the event will take a detailed look at two of the functional requirements of Building Regulations when designing non-domestic steel buildings - fire and the importance of air-tightness.

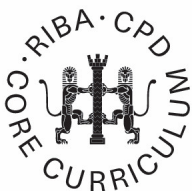
