
Guidelines for entering the RIBA International Awards 2010

If the building is outside the EU it should be entered for the RIBA International Awards. If a practice based outside the UK builds within the EU it should also be entered for the RIBA International Awards.

Winning schemes will continue to be considered for the Lubetkin Prize.

The rules of the RIBA International Awards are the same as those for the RIBA Awards, except that an A1 board must be submitted (see below).

The A1 presentation board

The grid: The grid is designed as a guide to laying out your board clearly, allowing you to adjust the display to suit your scheme whilst maintaining a united aesthetic with the other submitted schemes. These boards will form part of a coherent exhibition of the winning projects.

Size and weight: All boards must be A1 size (890 x 594mm) 5mm foam board and formatted landscape.

Typeface: Please use Arial, and if unavailable, a similar sans serif typeface.

Text, size and line spacing:

Name, location and country of scheme *Separated by commas*

Architect and client names *On separate lines*

Project Description *Up to 500 words*

Award eg RIBA Award or RIBA International Award *At bottom of board similar typeface size to the name of project.*

Packaging: Please ensure that your board is well protected. If your board is damaged in transit we will contact you to provide another.
