In January 2007 RIBA Trust/Arts Inform established a programme, Architects in Residence: Designing a Greener London, in partnership with RIBA London.

Fourteen architecture practices partnered fourteen London primary and secondary schools from the Boroughs of Camden, Greenwich, Newham, Tower Hamlets and Westminster, working with over 400 pupils to develop their plans for a greener London neighbourhood or locality.
