Election Statement:

I am a proud member of RIBA, and passionate about our East Midlands Region. Having trained at the School of Architecture in Leicester and the Architectural Association in London. I registered as an Architect in 1979, (ARB Reg No. 047923C) since when I have been in Full Time Practice.

I formed my own Architects Practice in 1991 at which time I joined the RIBA. (No. 6288025) That became The Drawing Room (Architects) Ltd. TDR (Chartered Practise No. 2072017P) We set up our TDR branch office in Derby in early 2016.

Prior to forming my own practise I worked initially for the Central Government's Property Services Agency PSA (Formerly Ministry of Public Works). Then various Private Practises including Pick Everards, working on Leicester Royal Infirmary Hospital, along side John Tiernan whom I persuaded to become President of the Leicestershire and Rutland Society of Architects LRSA. I also had six years in Local Authority with Leicester City Council, along side Tony Parr who I also later persuaded to become President of LRSA.

My own LRSA involvement started with attending the Sole Practitioners Group meetings, which lead onto being the groups representative at LRSA meetings. As TDR began to grow and I was no longer a sole practitioner I served as LRSA Treasurer for many years. When Tony Parr became Chair of Regional Council, I became Regional Treasurer. The East Midlands Regional Director at that time was Gwen Cotterill RIBA, with whom I worked closely for many years. After Gwen unfortunately died, Mike Baulcombe became Regional Director, shortly after then 'One RIBA' came into being and the Regional Treasurer role ceased to exist. However I remained on Regional Council as I then had the honour of serving as President of Leicestershire and Rutland Society of Architects LRSA. I have a particular interest in Housing through my involvement with the Housing Corporation and Grand Designs Live. I also have a long held believe in RIBA and Royal Town Planning Institute RTPi working in collaborative ways for the greater good of our Built Environment. I would be honoured to serve my Profession at National Level and be a strong advocate for our East Midland Region.
